- 4) Emergency Aid Funding Report and Request from Edmonds College Foundation Brad Thomas (1:42-2:10pm)
  - a) Provide 298 scholarships \$390k support to students, 12 stories
  - b) Impactful programs learning in and out of classroom
  - c) Expanding horizons: one day conf for females in ms and hs interested in stem fields facilitated by female community members. Plants seeds in communities young members for the future; key notes astronaut from nasa, alumni w/ own tech company. Great for prospective students and the community, Foundation is the primary sponsor to promote diversity on campus and in the fields.
  - d) Scholarships, impactful programs, emergency funding
  - e) 8 committee members for reviewing emergency funding meets weekly
  - f) \$30k EC Foundation's annual emergency assistance budget
  - \$50k campaign, raised \$20k and asked for 10k from asec last year, asec gave
     \$50k
  - h) 321 avg per award, 130 students
  - i) 2019-2020 foundation provided \$86,823.81 in emergency assistance aid to edmonds college students (\$56,823.81 more than our annual budget)

- j) Since march 2020, 190 students helped \$72,820.21 provided covid-19 emergency; other funding Safeway/Albertsons, US Bank, Foundation Board of Directors
   k) \$29,785.14 in housing assistance, max award \$500
- 1) \$26,365 food assistance
- m) \$8,542 utility assistance
- n) \$6,511 transportation assistance
- o) \$1,616 medical
- p) \$12k fall quarter already provided, anticipated to run out of funds by end of quarter
- q) Requesting \$20k for remainder of fall and winter quarter for student emergency assistance
