2009 Visual Arts Scholarship for Edmonds Community College Arts Program

The Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation (EAFF) annually provides art scholarships to students enrolled

in the Art curriculum of Edmonds Community College.

<u>The Award</u> - The EAFF offers annual tuition grants of up to \$1,500 each. These certificates of award are conditional upon acceptance of the students for the following year in college or university level art curriculum. Upon receipt of enrollment notice, the Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation will forward a check for the amount of the award to the student's tuition account.

<u>Selection Process</u> - A selection panel consisting of Edmonds Community College art instructors and at least one member of the EAFF Scholarship Committee, using established evaluation criteria, will select and recommend applicants to the Scholarship Committee for final approval. Scholarships are subjective and awarded at the sole discretion of the EAFF. Applications may be refused for any reason.

Eligibility - Any student currently enrolled in the Art curriculum at Edmonds Community College,

pursuing a full time degree in art, and planning to attend college during the next academic school year may apply.

Application Requirements

- 1. A completed Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation scholarship form.
- 2. An official copy of current Edmonds Community College transcript.
- 3. A letter of scholastic and artistic intent.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation. One must be from a college arts instructor.
- 5. A portfolio of artwork demonstrating work in at least two visual arts disciplines. Maximum of 10 pieces (slide or actual work).
- 6. Scholarship recipiants are required to volunteer 3 hours at the 2009 Edmonds Arts Festival. Volunteer opportunities begin June 12 and continue through June 21.
- 7. Applications must be presented to the art department faculty no later than:

Deadline

Friday, March 13, 2009 by close of office day. No applications will be accepted after this date.

Renewal - Once a student has been selected in the scholarship process, renewal of funding is possible on an annual basis. The EAFF should be advised by Feb 15th with a letter of intent. A renewal application will then be sent. The following criteria must be met for renewal consideration of the EAFF Scholarship:

- 1. Full-time student status in an accredited art school, college, or university.
- 2. Satisfactory progress toward a college degree in art.
- 3. Official school transcripts of work completed in the current college year.
- 4. One letter of reference from a college level art instructor.
- 5. 5–10 samples of your current artwork (presented in any format photographs, slides, CD, photocopies, etc.)
 - 6. The completed EAFF Arts Scholarship Renewal form.
 - 7. Scholarship recipiants are required to volunteer 3 hours at the 2009 Edmonds Arts

Festival.

Volunteer opportunities begin June 12 and continue through June 21.
