*Accreditation- Being done at a distance. No in-person travel funds are available at this time*

*Articulation agreements- (not discussed: Update: the UW articulation agreement is dead. They really don't want it anymore. A student has successfully entered into Indiana State's online PM program with ease. Discussions have begun and it is a better fit for our students due to being online is the logic stream)*

*Admin support Issues- College Admin is at minimal levels. The department is not getting the usual support due to understaffing. The college admin staff is performing amazingly with minimal staff and more are being brought on is our understanding.*

*Outreach- is a major focus of the department right now*

*MasterBuilders- A reawakening of an old very tight relationship with MasterBuilders is underway.
