



# CONFIRMING YOUR PROGRAM

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### **Q:** Why am I being asked to confirm my program?

**A:** We want to be actively involved in helping you reach your academic goals. To accomplish this, we'll do regular checks on your program by asking you to do a guick update each guarter, when you register for classes. If you change your program, we'll update your student record (within 7 days).

### Q: Could changing my program impact my financial aid/funding?

**A:** It's possible that a change in your program might have some bearing on your financial aid or funding source. To determine how a program change may affect you, it's best to submit a financial aid support request form.

# Q: What if I don't see my program?

**A:** Academic programs sometimes change titles, departments and/or categories -- this can sometimes make them a little tricky to find. If you're not sure that you've made the right selection, the registration office can help: registration@edcc.edu

#### Q: I need help choosing a program. How do I find assistance?

A: Let's take a look at your strengths and interests, and determine the best academic path to get you to your goals. Visit our Advising Resource Center, or email them at: advising@edcc.edu. If you're an International Student on a non-immigrant visa, you'll want to contact an advisor from International Student Services at: iss advisors@edcc.edu. We've got additional resources in the list to the right that could help you find your path.

#### Q: What if I need to change my program in the middle of the quarter?

**A:** It's possible that program changes may lengthen the time it takes to complete a degree or certificate. Since program changes may also have immigration implications for International Students, we recommend that all students talk with their advisor first. Once you're ready, you can submit your program change by completing the online form.
