

University of Nagasaki Exchange Application

Program Dates: Fall & Winter Quarter
(Approx 9/27 - 2/15)

Estimated Program Cost: ~\$5,500
Application deadline: February 16th, 2022

Spend a semester at the University of Nagasaki (UN), located on the southern island of Kyushu. In addition to studying Japanese language and culture, you will take other classes (with English language support) alongside UN's own student body. You will spend your time in furnished apartments, no more than 30 minutes from campus, during your stay.

For fourteen weeks, you will be immersed in Japanese life: eating, commuting, and studying with your Japanese peers. During this time, you will also have the chance to meet students and other people from countries around the world. As an old trading port, Nagasaki enjoys a mix of architectural styles, cuisines, and traditions. This program is a unique opportunity to become completely immersed in Japanese language and culture and take your Japanese studies to the next level.

Admission Eligibility

To take part in the Nagasaki Exchange program you must meet the following requirements:

- Have taken at **least** two or three quarters of Japanese language by the time the program begins
- Have taken at least 12 credits at Edmonds College
- Have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Will be 18 years of age or older once the program begins

Application Requirements

To complete your application for the Nagasaki Exchange Program, please turn in the following materials to the Study Abroad Offices

- This application packet
- A one-page personal essay explaining: why you would like to be a part of the exchange program and how you will relate your experience to your goals or career path
- Two letters of recommendation (one must be from an Edmonds College faculty member) that support your desire to be an exchange student
- Your most recent unofficial transcript that states you have at least a 2.5 GPA, will have taken one full year of Japanese by the time of departure, and have taken at least 12 credits through Edmonds College
