 - Training in interpreting career related assessments with clients
- Weekly <u>individual supervision</u> and monthly <u>group supervision</u> provided by a licensed mental health counselor and approved Washington State Supervisor
- Maintain a manageable caseload of clients and minimal paperwork
- · Experiment with various therapeutic approaches
- Monthly professional trainings

Qualifications

- Currently enrolled graduate students who are completing requirements for a Master's level degree in mental health counseling, psychology or closely related fields of study.
- Demonstrated interpersonal communication skills and professional demeanor.
- Interest in counseling in higher education, college student development and social justice.
- Candidates must be able to work within the Counseling and Resource Center's normal operating hours (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday from 8-5, Tuesdays from 8-7 and Fridays from 8-4).
