- Interviewing community members
- Editing and producing at least two 60-90 second features weekly
- Creating and posting content to social media

Required skills for this position include:

- Basic understanding of social media
- Basic computer knowledge and some online experience
- Willingness to work with people of differing backgrounds and lifestyles
- Desire to learn about commercial radio and work in the local community beyond the campus
- Being self-motivated and able to budget time independently

Preferred skills include:

- Some journalism experience
- Reliable transportation and up-to-date auto insurance a plus but not required. (In order to drive station vehicles, WA DL and driving record check will be required.)
